Scholarship application instructions

Dear Applicant,

The Ohio State University Alumni Scholars Program is intended to provide recognition and financial assistance to outstanding incoming freshmen. The Ohio State University Alumni Association coordinated the program, with the support of the Alumni Club of Franklin County, the Offices of Admissions and Financial Aid, and The Office of University Development.

The Alumni Club of Franklin County will award a \$3,000 scholarship for the 2014-2015 academic year. The scholarship is based on academic achievement, school and community involvement and financial need. The minimum qualifications for the scholarship are:

- Admission to any campus of The Ohio State University (required)
- Resident of Franklin county or graduate of a high school located in Franklin County, Ohio (required)
- Not an Ohio State student athlete.

Additional selection criteria include:

- Academic achievement High school class ranking
- High school class ranking
- Involvement in school and community activities
- Financial need

Finalists for the scholarship will be required to interview with the scholarship selection committee.

Applicant must complete Part I of the application. Part II must be completed by your school principal, counselor or a teacher. It is important for the person(s) completing Part II to attach a copy of your transcript to your application. The completed application, with transcript, must be mailed to the contact person listed in Part III of the application and **postmarked no later than January 11, 2017.**

Applicant must also complete The Ohio State University Admission Application form and be admitted to the University in order to be considered for this scholarship. The application can be found in The Ohio State University Viewbook and Freshman Application booklet. Viewbooks are available from your high school guidance counselor or you may apply on line. If you wish to file for a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), it is also available through your counselor or on the web at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Completion of the FAFSA form is NOT REQUIRED for this scholarship nor will it be reviewed by the Alumni Club of Franklin County scholarship committee.
