So we have a review committee that has been working on that process, but we need your input as well.

According to the rules, we will present the constitution to the membership for all to see. This process must be completed by February. The most effective way to share the documents with everyone is to post them on our website, as well as email them to you. You are welcome to submit comments or questions. Voting will happen at our regular monthly meeting in February. Everyone is welcome to attend any of our meetings as always.

Please feel free to contact anyone on the review committee with questions, comments, etc. We will list those contacts in the email and on the website when the time comes. We value the input of all our members and want you to be a part of this process.

SCHOLARSHIP PLANNING BEGINS

One of the main goals of our club has always been to raise funds for our scholarship, which is awarded each year to an incoming freshman from here in Franklin County. This year's process has begun – 50 local high schools have received the information for our 2016 scholarship, which will be a \$3500 award.

Applications are due January 13, and soon after that Scholarship Committee Chair, Brad Farmer, will need volunteers to review the applications. Then in



February we will need volunteers to interview the top candidates. This is a very rewarding experience, meeting these outstanding young people who are ready to begin their Buckeye education!
