

### SCOONIE PENN AT ANNUAL BANQUET

James "Scoonie" Penn, star of the 1999 Buckeye Basketball team that went to the Final Four, will be our guest speaker at the Franklin County OSU Alumni Club annual banquet on Wednesday, May 11. The banquet will recognize our newest scholarship winner and celebrate the accomplishments of the club throughout the past year.

Scoonie is a two-time NCAA All-American and Ohio State University Hall of Fame basketball player. He played two seasons for the Ohio State Buckeyes, leading them to their first Final Four appearance in more than 20 years. He finished his Buckeye career as the all-time leader in three-point shooting. After his playing years were over, Scoonie tapped into his passion as an entrepreneur



and motivational speaker, using his life's experiences to motivate youth and corporate audiences. Currently, Scoonie is working as a basketball analyst for a number of television and radio stations, as well as CEO of POWR Management. He is also the recipient of numerous community awards.
