Due to changes in the scholarship application process, we anticipate a higher than usual number of applicants this year, so we need several additional volunteers to read and score the applications.

The recipient will be introduced at our annual Membership Party in June.

#### MONDA STUDENT RESOURCE CENTER

Some surprising facts from the 2024 Ohio State Student Life survey:

- 32 % of Ohio State students experience food security
- 8,458 number of visits to the Buckeye Food Alliance food pantry during the 2023-24 academic vear
- 24 % of Ohio State students who could not come up with \$400 in an emergency
- 316 number of students who received Student emergency grants in 2023-24 academic year

The need is truly real.

In Spring 2025, the Monda Student Resource Center will debut in a remodeled Younkin Hall at 1640 Neil Avenue. The center will be a "one stop shop" for students to get food through the Buckeye Food Alliance, hygiene products, clothing (personal and professional), emergency grants, and safety devices.

Our club will help support this new center by sponsoring a food drive next month (April). We hope to make donating items easy by setting up an Amazon Wish List with purchased items directly shipped to the Monda Center. Stay tuned to find out how you can help with this great need.
